RE: BLUESTONE RECRUITMENT - VOLUNTARY ADMINISTRATION

Further to our conversation regarding your letter of 11 August 2014 and the voluntary administration of the Bluestone Group, we request the following information:

- 1. How many casuals employees are now employed by Ranstad?
- 2. Can you confirm that Randstad will ensure no employees are out of pocket?
- 3. What are the names of the other employment agencies that employees have transferred to?
- 4. We would expect that no employees will be out of pocket. Can you advise what steps Australia Post will take to ensure this happens?
- 5. Are any casual employees currently waiting for a pay period?
- 6. We would expect all affected casual employees to be paid up to date by COB Friday, 15 August 2014. Can you confirm that this will occur?
- 7. What steps are Australia Post taking to ensure that casual employees, who are currently waiting for a pay period, have sufficient monies to travel to and from work and to purchase meals?
- 8. Can you advise of the length of casual service for each of the 26 employees.
